## FasTrak Offered For New South Bay Toll Road

**SAN DIEGO** -- A South Bay commuter waited in line more than 16 hours to win a year of free travel on the new South Bay Expressway.

The first person in line to open a FasTrak account on the toll road won the grand prize. The next 25 people in line won free six-month passes on the expressway.

The South Bay Expressway is a toll road being built east of Interstate 805 from Otay Mesa to Bonita. It connects Interstate 905 near the border to state Routes 54 and 125.

FasTrak is a transponder that saves money and time by allowing customers to drive through toll plazas without stopping. Tolls on the expressway will initially range from 25 cents to \$1.75 per trip.

Dober Fernandez from Eastlake won the one-year pass.





The new expressway is scheduled to open in late September.
