South Bay Expressway and **Caltrans'** mitigation program for State Route 125 South was named an Exemplary Ecosystem Initiative by the **U.S. Department of Transportation's Federal Highway Administration**. The 10-mile Expressway, extending from SR 54 in Spring Valley through eastern Chula Vista to the SR 905 in Otay Mesa near the border crossing, was one of only 20 ecosystem initiatives chosen, nationwide.
